

Marriage enquiry

Thank you for your marriage enquiry. As a parish church within the Church of England our first priority is to marry those people who are either currently members of our church or currently live within our parish, one of you need to meet this criteria to be married here under this option.

You can check whether you live in our parish by going to

To be a member of our church means that you will already be on our membership list here having met the criteria through regular worship in the past.

If you meet either of these criteria but one of you has a passport other than an English one you will need in addition to get a license and we can help you do that,

From 2008 church legislation has opened up the possibility for others to get married in our church. You may be able to marry here...

If one of you:

- was baptised in the parish.
- was confirmed from this church
- has ever lived in the parish for at least 6 months
- has regularly attended public worship in the parish for at least 6 months

If a parent of one of you

- lived in the parish for at least 6 months
- regularly attended public worship in the parish for at least 6 months

Or if a Parent or Grandparent of one of you was married in this church.

For us to consider you for marriage under the newer legislation we need you to provide proof by way of legal records or formal documents. We can advise you on what these might be should you wish to proceed.
